

Beaver Lake—Derry NH



Observations:

Beaver Lake is a .5 mile long and .75 mi long. It is a very easy and quick paddle,. The launch area is spacious, level with plenty of parking. The beach is for Derry residents only but the launch area is open to the non-residents. There is not much to see other than seasonal and year round cottages. It is very easy to navigate and get around in most wind conditions. We usually paddle the perimeter of the lake and watch the people working on their cottages or lounging by the water's edge. Very little wildlife has been present when we have visited. Be aware that this lake is only accessible from Derry Beach which is only open from Memorial Day through Labor Day.
