HICKORY WOODS BOARD OF DIRECTORS ANNOUNCEMENTS

MAY 21, 2020: During our Board meeting yesterday, we discussed the use of the outside Clubhouse facilities. Effective Friday, May 22, the patio, grill and firepit will be available for Unit Owner use with the following restrictions:

- (1) Social distancing guidelines, provided by the state of New Hampshire, will need to continue to be followed.
- (2) Guests from outside the community will continue to be restricted from all clubhouse facility use.
- (3) Spray bottles filled with cleaner and paper towels will be available for Unit Owners to clean tables and chairs for their own use

The use of all facilities are at your own risk, the HOA is not responsible for any illness that may occur from use.

APRIL 15, 2020: During this ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, your Board of Directors want to share the following information regarding the use of our Outside Facilities:

- (1) The use of all outside facilities is limited to Hickory Woods residents only. No guests will be allowed at this time.
- (2) The golf nets are now up and can be used by any resident. We ask that everyone remember the importance of social distancing to allow safe use for everyone.
- (3) The pickleball court nets will be hung within the next few days. Again, we ask that everyone remember to socially distance themselves especially if waiting for a court to play on.
- (4) Unfortunately, the use of our outside grill and fire pit is **not allowed**. These two items encourage social gatherings for larger groups and for a greater period of time.

Finally, we ask that all personal trash be placed in each unit owner personal trash bins. The clubhouse trash bins is only for clubhouse use. Pet droppings are never acceptable.

Tuesday, March 31, 2020: As we continue to struggle with the Covid 19 pandemic, your Board of Directors is requesting that *anyone coming back to Hickory Woods, from out of state, self isolate for 14 days.* This is the guideline Governor Sununu set forth yesterday. Since we have elected to keep the clubhouse available to our community, the request is especially important to our neighbors. For those neighbors who continue to use the clubhouse, please remember that it is critical to clean anything touched before and after use. **Use of the clubhouse is at your own risk and its safety cannot be guaranteed.**

Tuesday, March 17, 2020: At this time, your Board of Directors have decided to keep the clubhouse open for those neighbors who would like to use it. We want to remind you that the use of the clubhouse is <u>at your discretion and your own risk.</u> We want to remind you to clean exercise equipment with the provided spray and paper towels. Additionally, we will be providing additional cleaning spray and paper towels in the upstairs rooms to allow you to clean surfaces used for games. Please be aware that the provided sprays are <u>not</u> considered foolproof in preventing the spread of Covid 19. *Please refer to CDC guidelines and/or your health care provider for questions regarding the Covid 19 virus.*
