

Observations:

Robinson Pond is a short drive and very enjoyable paddle. The launch area is level with plenty of parking. This pond is generally calm and stronger wind conditions still make it fairly easy to navigate. Once you depart the launch area, you can go to the right around the corner and paddle through a very shallow area of wetlands. Not sure if this area dries up too much in summer months so please proceed with caution. We saw turtles, herons, geese, and ducks while there in mid-April. Continuing to paddle to the left along the western shoreline has a few camps but not too over developed. If you are looking for an convenient paddle close to home, you can't do much better than Robinson Pond!

Directions

Exit HW on RT 102. Take right heading west on Rt. 102. Take right at 1st light onto Robinson Rd. (Irving Gas on left). Follow for ~2 miles. Look for lake on right. Boat launch area in lot before entrance to Robinson Park.
