

Pawtuckaway Lake—Nottingham



Observations:

Pawtuckaway Lake is a beautiful lake with natural shorelines and few cottages. There are two places to launch boats: Fundy Cove Boat Launch on the NW corner of lake and from Pawtuckaway State park (\$5 fee). We have only launched from Fundy so far. The parking lot is quite large and launch area flat and easy access. We have seen the lot fill up by 9 am during busy weekend and holidays so best get there early. Once paddling, you go through a narrow cove and out toward the larger bod of water. Due to the shape of lake and typical wind directions, wind is not too much of a factor during our paddle even though winds were strong. The shoreline is most nature with a few cottages lining some parts of the area. Beware of some areas of low water level due to drought. Lake is too large to paddle entire lake in one day. After a morning paddle, head to Tuckaway Tavern in Raymond for a great lunch!

Directions

Exit HW on RT 102. Go left on Rt 102 for 29 mi. to Raymond . Take left on Rt. 27 then take first right at light on Rt 156 Nottingham Rd. Go for 5.4 miles then take left on Deerfield Rd. Go for 1.9 miles then take Fundy Rd (look for sign on right for Fundy Boat Launch). Take left of Fundy Launch Rd for about 1/2 mile. Launch area is at end of road.
