

## **Canobie Lake - Salem NH**

Wind Factor: Fairly Easy In Moderate Winds


Nature: Moderate some wildlife in marsh areas

## **Observations:**

Canobie Lake is a water supply for the area. This means that there is no swimming and no part of the body can touch the water. It is suggested you wear rubber boots to launch and remove boats. Launch area is right off road and offers plenty of parking. It can get busy on weekends in summer and lot can fill up. Lake is 1.4 mi long and .14" mi wide. Launch area is very level and easy to get in and out. Once launched go to the right and you will see parts of Canobie Lake Amusement Park. In season you can see and hear the shrills of the rides. They also have a boat that cruises around the lake. There are a fair amount of cottages and year round homes. If you go to the NW corner of the lake, there is a nature area where you can spot various fish, turtles and other wildlife. There is not much else to see but it is a good way to spend a few hours. You will see many fisherman and boats during busy times of the year.

## **Directions**

Exit HW on RT 102. Take left heading east on Rt. 102. Take RT 93 South. Take exit 3 In Windham. Take left off exit on RT 111. Go to Rd. At 2nd light, take left on N. Policy Rd. Take Right on Range Rd (just past Castle). Take right at 1st light on to N. Policy Rd. Go ~ 1/3 mi and launch area is on left.
