Three Parts of Local Government

- Town Budget: Approx. \$35 million
- School Budget: Approx. \$80 million
- Library: Approx. Approx. \$1.3 million (part of Town budget)

Other Revenue

Town: \$17+ million (motor vehicle, state highway, building permits, etc.)

School: \$21 million (state aid, tuition, etc.)

Property tax breakdown: 64% Residential, 19% Commercial, 17% Utility

Tax Rate

Town: \$4.56

School (local): \$12.04

School (state): \$1.91

County: \$0.88

TOTAL: \$19.39

Londonderry Public Safety

Salary and Benefits:

LPD: 67 sworn officers (incl. Airport), \$9,334,748

LFD: 50 certified firemen, \$6,202,697

DPW: 13 highway foremen, \$1,371,616

- Defibrillators in all vehicles
- Three 24/7 Ambulances w/Advanced Life Support
 - Avg. response time: ~6 minutes
- Calls for Service
 - LFD: **4,013** (2018)
 - LPD: **7,605** (2019)
